

-100k+ entries in most medical dictionaries.

So strategy for learning MT:

1. Memorize word parts
2. Learn how to combine them
3. Listen and practice saying them

Interpreting Word Parts

- : usually serves to further define the word root
- : usually describes what is happening to the word root
- : main words or parts to which prefixes and suffixes can be added.

Interpreting Word Parts

- Impossible to memorize all the med words individually, so break it into parts
- These word parts are used over and over in different combinations
- If the word parts are known, the word can be broken down and interpreted
- It is also important to learn know the correct spellings so medical terms will be interpreted properly

Interpreting Word Parts

- Prefixes and suffixes have set meanings
- When prefixes, suffixes, and/or word roots are joined together, vowels are frequently added
- Common vowels used: , , , , , ,
- Vowels are not used if the word root or suffix begins with a vowel
